Have you ever wanted to get a URL typed as quickly as possible in the Address Bar but wind up having to also type the www. and the .com? Well I know I have, and I have also found a way to finish the URL faster.

For most of you who don't know, CTRL+Enter will automatically fill in the www. and the .com for you. But there are more keys to even add .net and .org! Yea that's right, you read correctly! So for these keys you will do exactly the same as CTRL+Enter except you change CTRL to something else.

Here is a chart that shows the keys that I have found so far.

CTRL + ENTER	.com
SHIFT + ENTER	.net
CTRL + SHIFT + ENTER	.org
CTRL + TAB	Changes tabs in browser
CTRL + F	Opens Find/Search Text box
CTRL + W	Closes the open tab
CTRL + Q	Shows multiple tabs as miniature windows in one screen
CTRL + E	Moves cursor to Search Engine bar
CTRL + R	Refreshes screen
CTRL + T	Opens new tab
CTRL + I	Opens Favorites menu
CTRL + O	Opens the Open prompt
CTRL + P	Opens Print menu
CTRL + A	Highlights everything on screen
CTRL + D	Opens Bookmark/Favorite add dialog box
CTRL + H	Opens History
CTRL + J	Opens RSS Feeds
CTRL + K	Opens current tab in new tab
CTRL + B	Opens Organize Favorites/Bookmarks box
CTRL + N	Opens current tab in a new window
